

#### 3. Warranty Instructions

#### 3.1Warranty instructions

#### Warranty object

Vehicles manufactured by GAC Motor Co., Ltd., sold and serviced by the authorized shop of the Company.

#### NOTE

You will lose the vehicle warranty rights if you do not fill in the warranty copy and make the warranty registration.

If the vehicle owner changes within the warranty period, the warranty is still valid.

#### Warranty period

The warranty period refers to the period or mileage calculated from the date the seller issues the purchase invoice.

Basic warranty period pf GA8: 60 months or 150,000 km (whichever comes first).

Range and warranty period of consumables and wearing parts

Quality warranty period (whichever is earlier)	Quick-wear and Consumable Parts and Component
6 months / 10,000 km	Vehicle Battery, Remote Control Battery
3 months / 5,000 km	Air Filter, Oil Filter, Fuel Filter, A/C Filter, Bulb, Spark Plug, Fuse, and Tire
6 months / 5,000 km	Driving Belt, Friction Plate, Clutch Disc, Windshield Wiper, Brake Disc

#### Warranty coverage

The warranty liability of GAC Motor is to repair products and the warranty coverage includes:

- Repair or replacement of parts being considered defective by GAC Motor.
- Repair of paint on vehicle body being considered defective by GAC Motor.
- 3. Man-hour cost for the above repair

#### Warranty terms

- When verifying the warranty items, the GAC Motor authorized shop will consider the following conditions that are outside the warranty coverage of the GAC Motor:
- a) The vehicle is used in a country or region other than that where the vehicle is sold.
- b) Any vehicle that is used as a taxi.
- vehicle damage caused by the maintenance, repair and adjustment performed in places other than the GAC Motor authorized shop.
- d) Vehicle defects caused by use of parts, lubricating grease and liquids other than genuine ones provided by GAC Motor.
- e) Vehicle damage caused by the driving methods other than those specified in the *Owner's Manual* or the operation outside the vehicle limit range (such as maximum load and seating capacity).
- f) Vehicle damage caused by application of corrosive or low-quality cleaning agent.



- g) Modification, addition, adjustment and removal of the vehicle prohibited 3. in the *Owner's Manual* without the approval of GAC Motor.
- Vehicle damage caused by abnormal use, improper handling, negligence or the operation performed by the unqualified or unskilled driver and the application for races (such as car race or motor rally).
- i) Sensation problems that do not affect the vehicle performance.
  - The warranty of GAC Motor does not cover the defective sensation problems that do not affect the quality, function or performance of products.
- j) Any damage caused by inappropriate storage or transportation.
- k) Vehicle defects caused by the natural disaster, fire, traffic accident, theft and the secondary damage incurred.
- Vehicle damage caused by the environmental conditions other than the normal operation conditions of household automobiles (such as air pollution, chemical compound, guano, sea salt or other corrosive substances).
- m) Vehicle corrosion or fault caused by the water immersion.
- n) Vehicle surface corrosion caused by the flying stone or external scratch.
- 2. The warranty does not cover the maintenance items, fluids and auxiliary materials that are not necessary for the warranty and maintenance.

The warranty does not cover the following incidental charges.

#### For example:

- Expenses for communication, mediation, meal and accommodation because of fault.
- Any relevant personal injury or property damage.
- The GAC Motor reserves the right to determine the repair methods and warranty coverage.
- 5. All parts under the warranty coverage are the property of GAC Motor.
- The fuel, lubricating grease and fluids specified by GAC Motor shall be used.

#### NOTE

To avoid the dispute over the 3-R's warranty liability, please note that:

- The dispute over the 3-R's warranty liability may arise if the vehicle is not sent to the GAC Motor authorized shop for regular maintenance and inspection according to the Owner's Manual and the Warranty Manual.
- The dispute over the 3-R's warranty liability may arise if the user changes the original state of fault deliberately after the fault occurs so that the fault cannot be identified or the user has fraudulent behavior.



#### 3.2 Responsibilities of vehicle owner

- 1. Bring your vehicle to the GAC Motor authorized shop for first maintenance within 5,000 kilometers or 3 months (whichever comes first).
- 2. Make sure that your vehicle is maintained and inspected at the GAC Motor authorized shop according to the regular maintenance schedule in this manual.
- 3. Inspect and repair any fault of your vehicle at the GAC Motor authorized shop in time, which may be covered under the warranty.

#### **◆** NOTE

- The dispute over the 3-R's warranty liability may arise if the vehicle is sent to any places other than the GAC Motor authorized shop for maintenance and repair.
- The vehicle that has not received first maintenance (within 5,000 km or 3 months (whichever comes first)) may lose the right of free first maintenance.

Please bring this manual with you when you go to the GAC Motor authorized shop.

#### 3.3Obligations of GAC Motor authorized shop

Complete the items in the warranty certificate of this manual and explain the warranty procedures of GAC Motor when delivering a new vehicle to the user.

Explain the importance of regular maintenance for the vehicle fully to the user.

Ensure that any maintenance and repair can be completed according to the standard specified by GAC Motor, whether they are covered under the warranty or not.

For the damage or defects under the warranty coverage, the authorized shop should provide necessary vehicle repair or treatment to the user.



#### 4. Maintenance Instructions

#### 4.1First maintenance agreement

The first maintenance must be completed within 5,000 kilometers or 3 months (whichever comes first).

The first maintenance is provided by GAC Motor free of charge. Please bring this manual to the GAC Motor authorized shop for first maintenance. The first maintenance includes:

- 1. Replacing the engine oil, the drain bolt washer and the oil filter.
- 2. Inspecting and adding:
  - a. Coolant
  - b. Brake fluid
  - Windshield washer fluid
- 3. Inspecting:
  - a. Battery charging condition
  - b. Operation of parking brake and brake pedal
  - The dust cover of transmission drive shaft for leakage or damage
  - d. Tightening condition of wheel fixing bolt

- e. Wear pattern and pressure of the tire/ hub (including the spare tire) (replace it when necessary)
- f. Whether the connection of steering tie rod is firm
- g. The condition of the underbody
- h. The condition of suspension ball joint and dust cover
- i. The condition of suspension assembly
- j. The operation of wiper/cleaner (adjust the nozzle when necessary)
- k. The operation of door check/ dowel pin, door lock, engine hood/ trunk lid hinge and latch
- I. The operation of interior and exterior lighting equipment and electric equipment of vehicle body
- m.. The thickness and wear pattern of the brake disc and brake lining
- n. The operation of headlamp
- 4. Cleaning:
  - a. A/C filter element
  - b. Air filter element
  - c. Drain hole of the front windshield drip channel
- Self-diagnosis:
  - a. Read OBD in-use monitoring data
  - b. Check the fault message with the professional diagnostic equipment

#### 4.3 Supplementary maintenance under severe driving conditions

The maintenance cycle is established based on the normal driving conditions, therefore if the vehicle is used under one or more severe driving conditions, the maintenance frequency for certain maintenance items should be increased or the maintenance cycle should be shortened.

The severe conditions include the followings:

- The vehicle often runs for a short trip.
- 2. The engine is kept running at an idle speed constantly and the vehicle runs intermittently (for example: the vehicle is used as a taxi)
- 3. The vehicle runs in a muddy, dusty area or environment.
- 4. The vehicle is used to tow the trailer frequently or to load the luggage on the roof luggage rack during running, or the vehicle runs on a mountain road
- 5. The vehicle runs for a long time in extreme cold (below the freezing point) or hot (higher than 35°C) climates.
- 6. The vehicle runs more than 20,000 kilometers every year or runs at a high speed frequently.
- 7. The vehicle runs a long distance at a low speed.
