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Warranty Objects

The vehicles manufactured by GAC Motor and serviced by the authorized GAC Motor dealers.

Note

If your failed to fill in the Warranty Page and has no warranty registration, you will be not rewarded the with warranty rights of your vehicle.

The warranty should be applied to the next owner. (During the warranty period, if you sell your vehicle, the warranty is still valid for the next owner.)

Warranty Per iod

The Warranty Period refers to the indicated time or distance calculated from the date of purchase invoice issued by the dealer.

Basic warranty period of vehicle: 60 months or 150,000km (the first coming one prevails).

Warranty period of quick-wear and consumable parts:

GAC Motor should provide free repair for any damage caused by any defect resulting from the quality of materials or manufacturing process.

During this period, if any defect occurs in your vehicle, the GAC Motor dealer will provide repair or replace the related parts according to the warranty conditions.

Warranty Coverage

The warranty responsibility of GAC Motor Co., LTD. is repairing the products, and the range of repair is including:

- Repair or replacement of defective parts approved by GAC Motor Co., LTD.
- 2. Repair of defective body paint approved by GAC Motor Co., LTD.
- Labour-hour costs required for the above corresponding repairs.

2. Warranty Instructions



Warranty Conditions

- 1. The GAC Motor dealers will consider the following factors which are not covered by the warranty:
- a) Driving your vehicle in a country or region other than the specified one.
- b) Using your vehicle as a taxi.
- Damage caused by the maintenance, repair and/or commissioning outside your dealer.
- d) Defects caused by using non-genuine parts, lubricants and/or liquids.
- e) Vehicle damage caused by negligence, error handling, any driving method other than that specified in the User's Manual or driving your vehicle beyond its limits (e.g., maximum load, seating capacity, etc.)
- f) Vehicle damage caused by corrosive or poor quality cleaning agents.
- g) Any modification, retrofitting, adjustment and/or removal without permission or prohibited in the User's Manual.
- h) Vehicle damage caused by non-ordinary use, error handling, negligence, driven by unqualified or unskilled drivers and/or used for competition (e.g., racing or rally, etc.)

- i) Feeling problems which do not affect the performance.
 - Any bad feeling which has no impact on the product quality, functionality or performance is not covered by the warranty.
- j) Any damage caused by improper storage or transport process.
- k) Any defect caused by natural disasters, fires, accidents and theft, as well as caused by their secondary damage.
- Any damage caused by the environmental conditions (e.g., industrial air pollution, compounds, bird droppings, sea-water salt or other corrosive substances) outside the control of GAC Motor.
- m) Any damage caused by time lapse (natural fading of painted surfaces, metal film peeling and other deterioration of plated surfaces).
- n) Corrosion and failure due to being all or partially submerged in water.
- Surface corrosion caused by uncontrollable flying stones or external scratches.

GAC MOTOR

- 2. The general maintenance items, such as oil, filters and others, are not covered by the warranty.
- 3. The following incidental expenses are not covered by the warranty.

For example:

- Communication, mediation, meals, accommodation and other expenses caused by vehicle failure.
- Any personal injury or property damage.
- GAC Motor reserves the rights to decide the repair methods and the scope of application of the warranty.
- All the parts which have been replaced in the scope of the warranty work belong to the property of GAC Motor.
- Use the fuel, lubricant grease and liquids specified by GAC Motor.

Note

To avoid controversy about the warranty responsibilities, pay attention to the following:

- Failure to have your dealer maintain check regular in accordance with the relevant requirements of the User's Manual and the Warranty Manual may cause controversy about the warranty responsibilities.
- When the vehicle fails, if you intend to destroy the original failure state, resulting in unidentified faults or fraud, and this may cause controversy about the warranty responsibilities.

2.2 Owner's Responsibilities

- 1. Go to GAC Motor dealer and operate the first maintenance for the first 5,000km or 3 months (the first coming one prevails).
- Be sure to have the GAC Motor dealer maintain and check your vehicle in accordance with the regular maintenance in this Manual.
- Have the GAC Motor dealer check and repair any fault in your vehicle in time, which may be covered by the warranty.

Note

- Any maintenance and repair on your vehicle outside the GAC Motor dealers may cause disputes about the warranty responsibilities.
- If you do not have the first maintenance (for the first 5,000 km or 3 months, whichever comes first), the vehicle will not be rewarded with the first free maintenance.

Be sure to carry this Manual with you when you go to GAC Motor dealer.

2.3 GAC Motor Dealer's Responsibilities

GAC Motor dealer should fill in the warranty items in this Manual at the delivery and explain warranty procedures relate to GAC Motor to customer.

Fully explain to the user the importance of regular maintenance.

Any maintenance and repair, whether covered by the warranty or not, should be done in accordance with the standards of GAC Motor.

GAC Motor dealer should perform necessary repair or maintenance on your vehicle's damage or defects covered by the warranty.



3.1 Agreement of First Maintenance

The first maintenance should be done within the first 5,000 km or 3 months (the first coming one prevails).

The first maintenance should be provided by GAC freely. Go to your authorized GAC Motor dealer to have first maintenance with this Manual. The first maintenance items include:

- 1. Replace the engine oil and the oil filter.
- 2. Check and add:
 - a. Transmission lubricating oil
 - b. Coolant
 - c. Brake fluid
- 3. Check:
 - a. Battery charging situation
 - Operating conditions of the parking brake and the brake pedal.
 - Transmission shaft dust boot for leakage or damage
 - d. Tightness of wheel fixing bolts
 - e. Wear and pressure in the tires /hubs (including the spare tire) (Replace if necessary)

- Whether the steering tie rods are securely connected.
- g. Conditions of under body.
- h. Conditions of the suspension ball joints and dust boots.
- i. Conditions under the suspension component
- Windshield washer fluid (add it if necessary) / operating conditions of wiper or washer unit (adjust the nozzles if necessary).
- k. Operating conditions of door checkers, fixing pins, door locks, engine hood /trunk hinge and lock catch
- Operating conditions of the interior and exterior lighting appliances and electrical equipment
- m. Thickness and wear of brake disc and brake lining
- n. Headlight operating conditions
- 4. Clean
 - a. A/C filter element
 - b. Air filter
 - c. Front windshield water-groove drain hole
- Self-diagnosis: Query fault information with the professional diagnostic equipment

3.3 Additional Maintenance under Severe Conditions

The maintenance period is determined based on normal driving conditions. If you use your vehicle in one or several severe conditions, you should increase the maintenance frequency for some maintenance items, or shorten the maintenance period.

The following situations belong to severe conditions:

- 1. Frequently short-trip driving
- 2. Engine continued idle running or driving of stop-and-go driving (eg. taxi)
- 3. Driving in muddy, dusty regions or environment
- 4. Frequently trailer towing, driving with car-top luggage rack, or driving in mountainous conditions.
- 5. Frequently driving in extremely cold (below freezing point) or hot (over 35℃) conditions
- 6. Driving over 20,000 km per year, or often driving at high speed, etc


